What is Law Firm Ready?

Law Firm Ready is mainly a pro bono mentoring initiative to provide guidance to law students aiming to join a law firm. The mentorship duration for **each new batch of mentees is almost 3 months**. During this 3-month period, our mentors are assigned one mentee per month, and that mentee is under their guidance for that particular period. At the end of the 3-month period, mentors are assigned new mentees.

MENTORS

Who is eligible to be a mentor?

Any lawyer currently working in a law firm, or who has previously worked in a law firm is eligible to be a mentor.

How long does the mentor have to be associated with Law Firm Ready?

The mentorship is very flexible and the mentor can choose to take a break for a few days or exit the program anytime. Mentors are required to inform Law Firm Ready team by sending a mail to “lawfirmready@gmail.com” before exiting the mentorship program.

Note: As Law Firm Ready assigns a new mentee to every mentor in the beginning of the month, it is assumed that the mentor will continue their association with Law Firm Ready, unless the mentor has informed the team otherwise.

MENTEES

How long is the mentorship program for mentees?

Over a period of 3 months, we try to assign mentees with a mentor. Due to the individual nature of the pairing process, we cannot give an exact time frame.

How are the mentees chosen by Law Firm Ready for the mentorship program?

The Law Firm Ready team takes the selection process very seriously and strives to ensure deserving candidates get selected for the mentorship program. The team shortlists candidates taking into account the answers of the candidates and the availability of mentors. Preference is given to students from private colleges and newer NLUs who do not have access to experienced seniors.
